


Hello!

We met in 2014, were married in the spring of 2019, and are delighted to embark on our 8th year in the city together.




The past several years of our lives have brought theatre outings, graduation dates, and marathon trainings.

The tree lined streets, vibrant playgrounds in every direction, and large community of friends and family make it a perfect place to raise a child.



All of Clint's family could not be happier when we shared our plans to adopt. They are already competing for who will get to hold your little one first!




daily adventures alongside mom, and special quality time with his dad.










Adam is truly one-of-a kind. I could not be more thrilled to watch him become a father. Most importantly, I cannot wait to watch your little one love him as much as I do.


