Tom's parents have both passed away, but their spirit remains with us every day. Kelly's Mom and Dad, retired medical professionals, are a big




part of our lives. They are more than ready to begin life as grandparents, providing daily support in our nurturing home.

OUR WEDDING DAY










THE KIDS




KELLY'S FAMILY




