




We are Adam, Clint, & Oscar from New York City.

We met in 2014, and were married in the spring of 2019. In 2021 we began our wonderful journey towards adoption.










Our prayers were answered the winter of 2024 when our perfect little Christmas miracle, Oscar, entered our lives.

We own our 2 bedroom home sweet home in our charming little co-op. Oscar's arrival also prompted Adam's parents to buy a studio apartment in the building.






Now all of our extended family can visit often.




