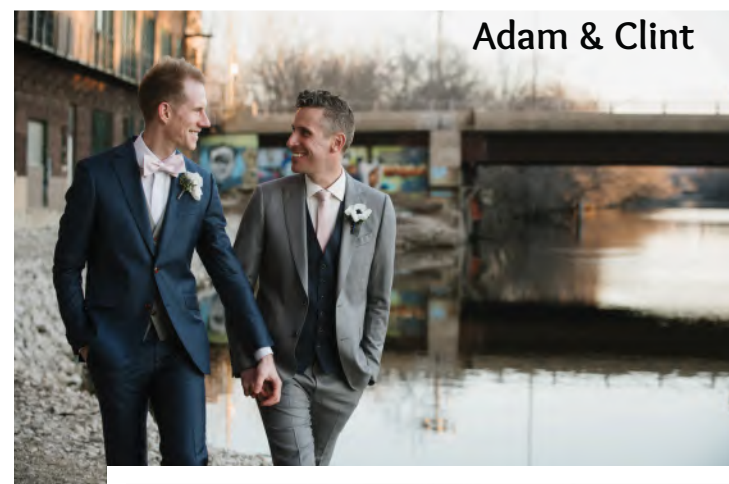
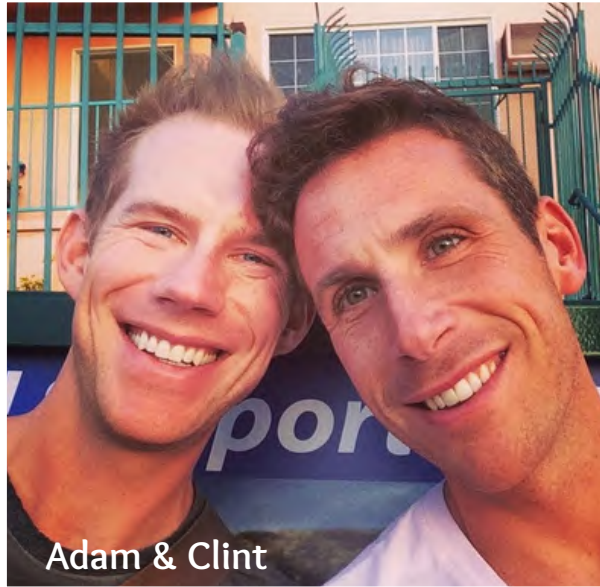
Hello!

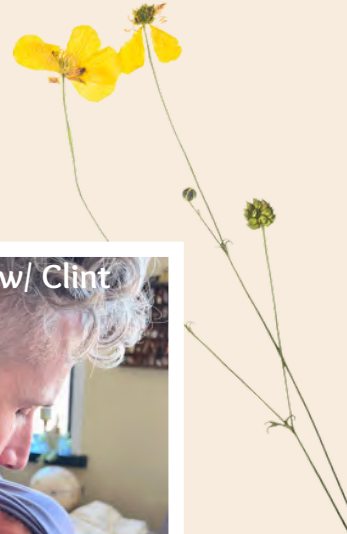
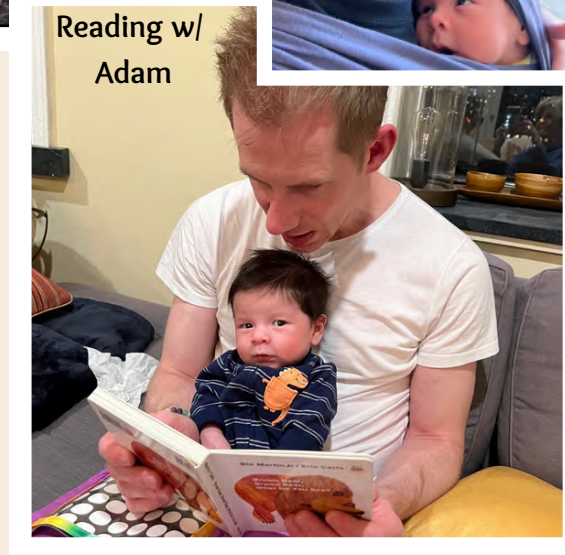
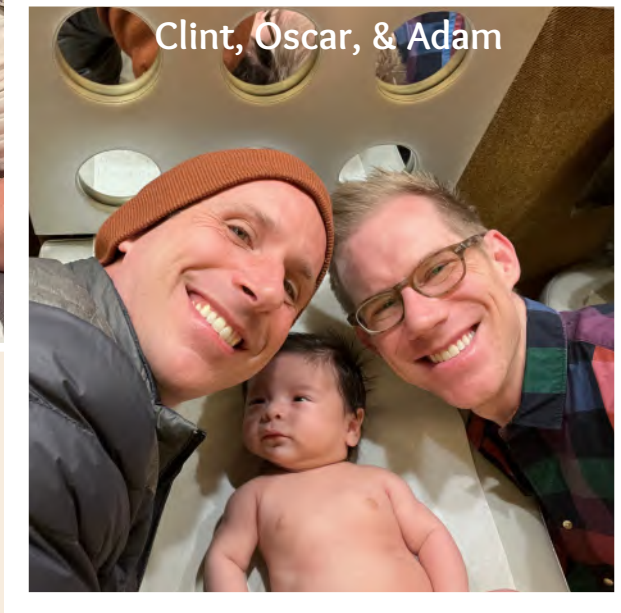
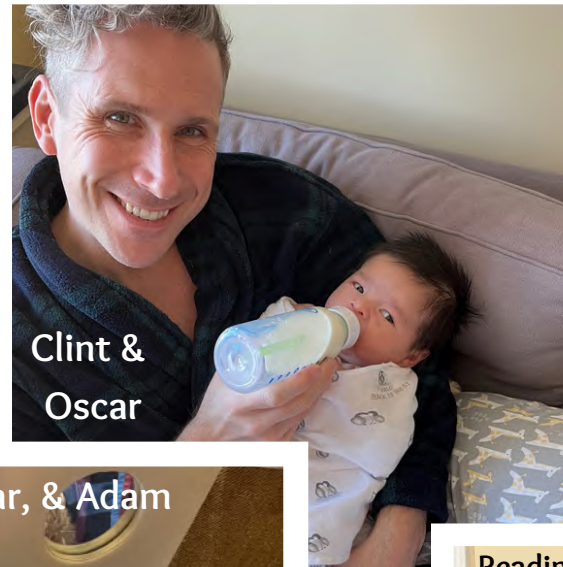
We are here to support you, and will be happy to answer any questions you may have for us. We look forward to hearing from you.

We live in a beautiful, family oriented neighborhood in Queens that we have fallen in love with over the years.





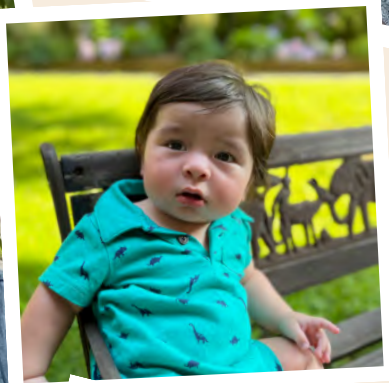

Clint also opened a private practice specializing in family & couples therapy. As co-owner and clinical director, he runs day to day business operations, supervises staff therapists, and sees his own case load of patients a few evenings each week.

As both a social worker and therapist, Clint spends a large part of his day navigating trauma and crisis with students and clients. His gentle demeanor, listening ears, and calm outlook transfer well to his role as a father.

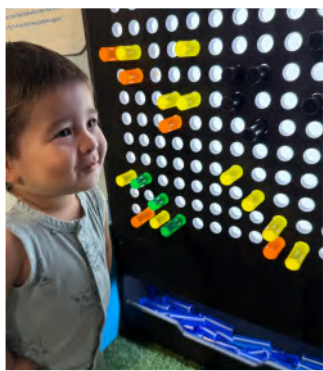
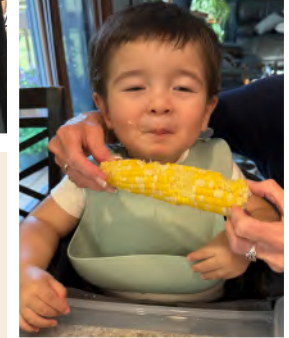

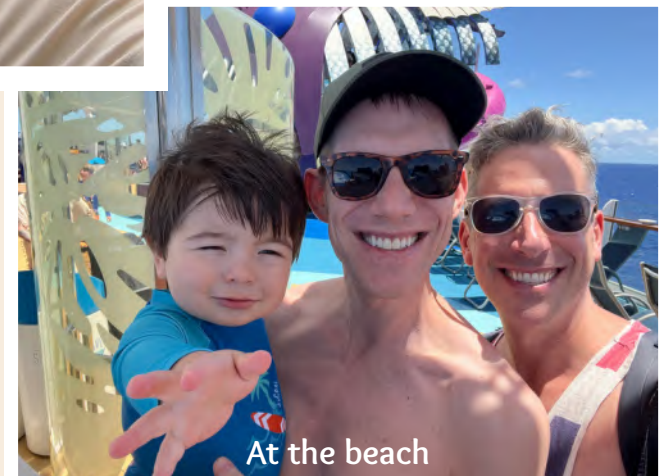
