


Dear Birth Parent,

bobby


Bobby works at an advertising agency, producing commercials for fashion, beauty, and retail brands. His job has taken him all over the world, from LA to Budapest.




childhood

Bobby with his mom and cousin


family & friends





His dad is from Maine and every summer we make a trip to visit his family there.




