












Things we love to do









































Friends



Our Neighbourhood

We live in a small village in the east of The Netherlands, surrounded by farms and countryside. We have plenty of local shops, restaurants and schools within walking distance. Our community is very close and everybody looks out for eachother. Your child will grow up with many friends living in our street and we will make sure that they spend a lot of time outdoors enjoying the nature and playing games. Our neighbors are very supportive and can't wait for all the children to grow up together. Our village is very beautiful and during the summer a lot of tourists come to enjoy the nature and relax here, as do we.













The Netherlands and some of our traditions

The photo above shows what our neighbours did for our wedding. They put an arch with handmade paper roses in front of our front door. On the arch is a sign with our names on it as well. We hang the Dutch flag on 2 days a year which are Kingsday and Liberation Day. We got married the day after liberation Day, so it was still up. The photo underneath is a 2-minute walk from our house and shows a traditional boat, made in our hometown, used back in the day for transport of goods. In the summers nowadays it is a tourist attraction and also sails daily for the schoolchildren of the many schools to learn about the history of the village.



Every year there is a Christmas Market on the townsquare. Where local shops sell their goods and the whole town comes together for hot chocolate and typical Dutch patries called 'oliebollen'. Every year we get a christmas ornament made there. The photo on the bottom is from the yearly picknic of many American adopted children here in the Netherland, which we will hopefully attend anually with your child.
